Faculty Recruitment: Degree Programmes

Applications are invited in the prescribed format for the faculty positions for Undergraduate degree and post-graduate degree programmes in Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electronics Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Production Engineering, Textile Engineering, Computer Engineering, Information Technology, and also for Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Master of Computer Applications in the Institute.

The Application should be submitted along with the processing fee of Rs.500/- for Open category candidates and Rs.300/- for backward class category candidates.

Candidates who have applied earlier with reference to advertisements of May and September 2009 need not apply again. However they should send updated resume if they desire to do so.

Candidates who had not sent applications in the format prescribed and with no processing fees, should send fresh applications in the prescribed format along with the processing fees.

Minimum qualifications, experience and scale of pay required for various posts will be as prescribed by AICTE and as approved by the State Government of Maharashtra.
